OVERVIEW

APPLICATION

- How has a lack of community affected you over the last several months? If you haven't been affected, how have you intentionally stayed in community?
- Look at the above verses. What are the characteristics shared in these verses about community and how God's people did life with one another?
- You don't have to wait on someone else for community. How are you intentionally reaching out to others to start the process of building community?
